In 2017, the Youth Vision for Society Association joined the cultural and artistic events organized by Bookstore&Tea in the city of Mangalia, making a significant contribution by initiating and co-organizing a series of innovative projects. This collaboration allowed the expansion of the cultural offer, including the introduction of new creative workshops for young people, a series of conferences on current topics and theater performances that attracted a diverse and enthusiastic audience. This synergy between the two entities complemented the local cultural scene, offering people valuable opportunities for learning and entertainment, as well as a space for expression and personal development for the Mangalia community.

BOOKSTORE - TEAHOUSE

Bookstore&Tea, a bookstore-teahouse located in Mangalia, was a center of local culture from 2013 to 2020. The space hosted a diverse range of events, attracting lovers of literature, art, and personal development. Activities included book launches, theater and music evenings, and pottery workshops, which provided a platform for authors and artists, both local and national. Special events were dedicated to national holidays, including exhibitions of traditional Romanian clothing and elements.

For young people and adults, Bookstore&Tea organized both socializing evenings and personal development workshops, and for the little ones, educational and creative activities specially designed for preschoolers. The location allowed for events to be held both inside the bookstore and in outdoor spaces on terraces or even on the beach, creating an ideal setting for thematic meetings, including those with historical themes.



Special guests, such as Dumitru C-tin Dulcan, Sebastian Lăzăroiu, Grigore Cartianu or Dragoș Pătraru, brought added value to the events, attracting a wide audience, interested in stimulating discussions and meetings with prominent personalities. Through all these initiatives, Bookstore&Tea not only promoted culture and education, but also constantly supported young writers and authentic Romanian values, thus consolidating its cultural role in the Mangalia community.



Muses and other sins

– BOOK LAUNCH

In a revitalized cultural setting, Bookstore&Tea, together with the Youth Vision for Society Association, hosted the book launch event for “Muze și alte știți” by Bianca Iordăchescu. This impressive debut work escapes the rigidity of traditional forms, offering a free and unconventional expression. The event was attended by renowned writers from the region, including Luiza Cală Cernăianu and professor Emil-Corneliu Ninu, creating an atmosphere of deep literary appreciation.



Poets and poetry at the seashore

In 2019, Bookstore&Tea Mangalia, together with the Youth Vision for Society Association, organized an event dedicated to local poets, where significant works of theirs were presented. Hosted right in the bookstore, the event managed to bring together important names from the local poetic landscape, such as Anca Bucur, Emilian Gui and Gabriela Apostu, providing an excellent platform for artistic dialogue.

Mihai Eminescu – 169 years old

Every year in January, Bookstore&Tea celebrates the work of Mihai Eminescu, and in 2019 the event benefited from the collaboration of the Youth Vision for Society Association. The poetry recital brought together poets and teachers, who honored the memory of the great poet through a series of inspired readings, thus marking the 169th anniversary of his birth and celebrating National Culture Day.

History and art evenings with Professor Dr. Aldea Gheorghe

- TRIBUTE

A tribute to Professor Dr. Aldea Gheorghe was organized by Bookstore&Tea and subsequently supported by the Youth Vision for Society Association.

Professor Dr. Aldea Gheorghe was a prominent member of the Mangalia community. Born in Saraiu commune, Constanța county, on October 24, 1923, Aldea Gheorghe was a sculptor and painter, a member of the U.A. P. since 1968, and a war veteran. Through thematic meetings on history and art topics, participants had the opportunity to learn about his significant contributions to local culture.



Theater evenings



Several theater evenings were held at the Bookstore&Tea bookstore in partnership with the local troupe Thaliamar and the Youth Vision for Society Association. Among the plays performed at the bookstore are: "Every Day" and "The Teenager's Monologues".

Waltz of the leaves of longing

- BOOK LAUNCH

In 2018, during an event organized by Bookstore&Tea in partnership with the Youth Vision for Society Association, the debut book "Walsul frunzelor de dor" (The Waltz of the Leaves of Longing) by the young Bessarabian poet Mariana Păduraru was launched.

The meeting was moderated by the president of the Romanian Language Writers' Union, Mrs. Diana Zlatna, as well as by Prof. Emil-Corneliu Ninu, the initiator of this meeting. Some of the writers belonging to the Solteris Arts Club from Mangalia were also present at this event.
